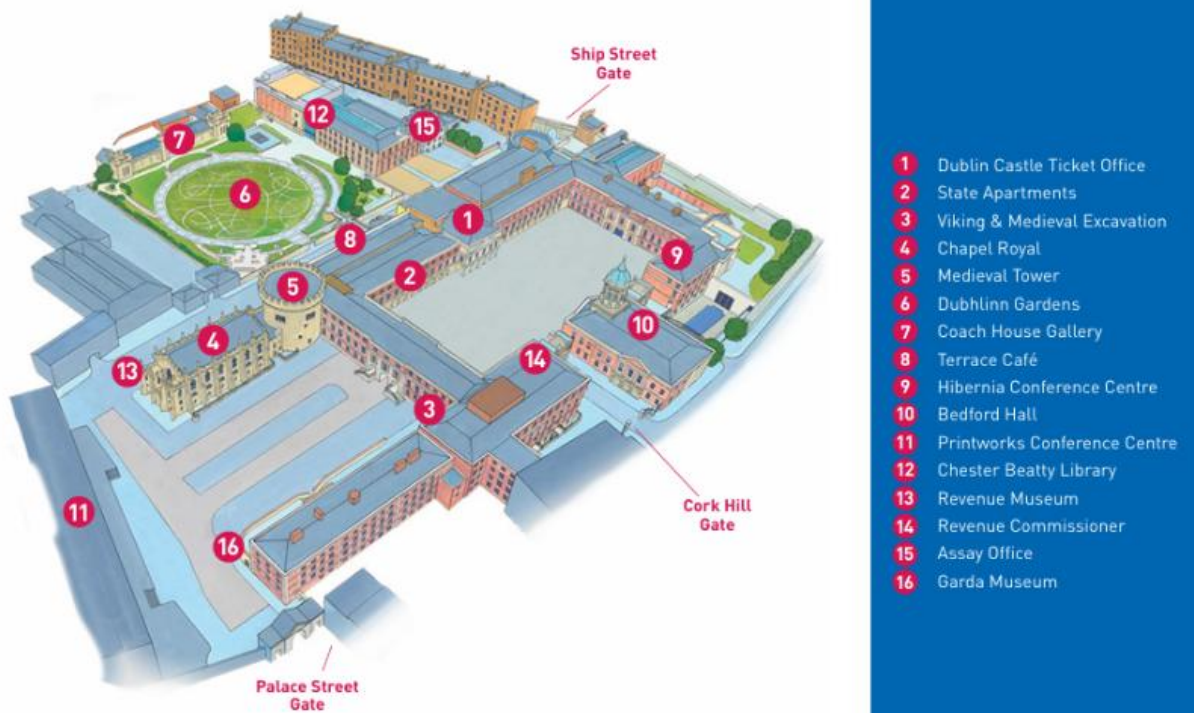

Entering Ireland

Please note that Ireland is not part of the Schengen Area. Therefore, **EU citizens must present a valid passport or national identity card to enter Ireland**. Full details are available [here](#).

Citizens of other countries must present a valid passport or recognised travel document to enter Ireland and may also need a visa. You can find out if you need a visa to enter Ireland [here](#).

Airport

Delegates are kindly requested to make their own arrangements for transfer to and from the airport.

Badges

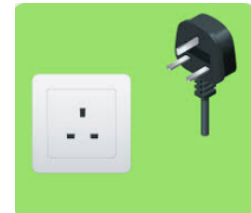
Time zone

Local time in Ireland is UTC+1 in summer.

Power supply and plugs

The standard electricity supply in Ireland is 230V at a frequency of 50Hz (the same as in other EU Member States) but three-pin power plugs and sockets of Type G are used.

Delegates travelling from EU Member States will require a type G (UK and Ireland) power plug adaptor in order to use electronic devices safely in Ireland.



Weather

The average weather in Dublin in July is 16°C, with highs and lows averaging between 12°C and 19°C.

Rain can be expected at any time of the year and it is advised to bring a raincoat with you in case of rain showers during the day.
