Request for Humanitarian Support

Dear Authorities of the Kingdom of the Netherlands,

I, 5.1.2.e residing in Kabul, Afghanistan, submit this letter with the hope that the voice of my family, as well as the voices of many Afghan women living under difficult circumstances, will be heard.

I am a graduate of 5.1.2.e Teacher Training Institute. Before the political changes in Afghanistan, I worked as a teacher in a private school and as an employee in a construction company. My husband was also a former officer of the Afghan National Army and served his country for many years.

Following the political changes in Afghanistan, the life of our family changed completely. My husband and I lost our jobs, and the opportunities we had worked so hard to build a better future disappeared. Widespread restrictions on women, economic hardships, and security concerns have made our daily lives extremely difficult.

Under the current conditions in Afghanistan, women face serious restrictions in employment, education, and social participation. Employment opportunities for women in the fields of education, administration, office work, and many other sectors have been severely restricted, while access to education and continuing studies has also become increasingly difficult. This situation has had a profound impact not only on the lives of women today but also on their future and the future of their children.

Our family consists of only three members: myself, my husband, and our four-year-old daughter. We are a small family with simple aspirations; we only wish to live in safety, work, provide education for our child, and have a brighter future ahead of her. Today, however, our greatest concern is the future of our young daughter, a child who should be spending her childhood with happiness, peace, and hope.

What causes us the greatest pain is the loss of security, hope, and the ability to plan for the future. Every child has the right to grow up in a safe environment, and every woman should be able to enjoy the right to education, employment, and a life of human dignity. Unfortunately, the current situation in Afghanistan has placed these fundamental rights beyond the reach of many families.

I still believe that human values, compassion, and support for vulnerable people can change lives. For this reason, I respectfully appeal to the Government and people of the Netherlands, who have consistently stood for human rights, human dignity, and the protection of those in need, to consider the situation of my family with humanity and understanding.

We seek only an opportunity to live in safety, to have access to work and education, and to build a better future for our daughter. I sincerely hope that our request will receive consideration and that an opportunity may be provided for our family to begin a safe and dignified life.

If required, I am prepared to provide documents related to my education, employment history, identity documents, and any other relevant records for review and verification.

Thank you sincerely for your attention, humanity, and kindness.
